	<p><b>Three-Ring Binder (At least 1"-1.5")</b> Try to get the one that has the rings on the far right and leaves the middle without rings (D-Ring). The one in the picture is Avery brand and comes highly recommended. Your child will also need a pack of either 5 or 8 tab dividers.</p>
	<p><b>Two Composition Notebooks (for Writing Seed Book)</b> Color/Style does not matter.</p>
<p>A)  OR B) </p>	<p>Please do one of the following (NOT BOTH):          -A) One large notebook that has at least five sections OR          -B) Five separate spiral notebooks with perforated edges. Please label each Notebook or section: Spelling, Math, Notes, Science and one that's blank (Not labeled)</p>
	<p><b>Markers, Crayons, and Colored Pencils</b> (Brand and amount do not matter—I have used my favorites as the sample).</p>

	<p><b>Highlighters (Orange, Pink, Green, Yellow and Blue) The brand does not matter.</b></p>
	<p><b>Pocket Folder</b> Oak Grove will NOT be providing Monday Folders this year. Please purchase ONE folder for this purpose</p>
	<p><b>Pencils- MUST be #2. I prefer that you do NOT purchase mechanical pencils!</b></p>
	<p><b>Scissors- We will use them for math activities and various arts and crafts activities. It'll be much easier if your child has their own pair.</b></p>
	<p><b>Glue Sticks (NOT LIQUID GLUE) - Please purchase enough for the entire school year. No more than five will be needed.</b></p>
	<p><b>Pencil Sharpener with enclosed case (to catch shavings)—NOT ELECTRIC!!! Electric sharpeners will be sent home.</b> This one pictured also sharpens crayons. It's a Duel Dome sharpener.</p>
	<p><b>Erasers—Can be cap style or blocks like the picture.</b></p>

	<p><b>Paper Clips-</b> Your child will need a box of medium or large clips.</p>
	<p><b>Pencil Box or Case</b> Please make sure this item is small enough to fit into your child's desk or backpack.</p>
	<p><b>Loose-Leaf Paper</b> (One pack to donate to the class and one pack for the notebook)—Please purchase Wide Ruled and not College Ruled.</p>
	<p><b>Page Protectors</b>—To safely hold important items to be used all year (Writing Workshop especially)</p> <p>Your child will need at least 50-100</p>
	<p><b>Dry Erase Markers and eraser-</b> We will be using the dry-erase boards throughout the year and each child will need their own marker/eraser to adequately participate.</p> <p>The colors do not matter- however most children prefer to have multiple colored markers to use.</p>
