CURRICULUM FOR THIS SCHOOL YEAR

TEXTBOOKS

At St. Sabina, we use the RCL Religious Textbooks Series in grades Pre. /K through grade 5.

Curriculum is as follows:

Pre/K: God Made the World: God made everything including people, animals, the earth, and friends. God made everything because He loves us.

Grade One: God Loves Us: God is our Father and he loves us so much that He sent us His Son, Jesus. Jesus teaches us about God and his love for us. Jesus sends us his Holy Spirit.

Grade Two: Jesus Shares God's Life: This is the First Eucharist and Reconciliation year so the lessons reflect that. There are also two companion books which are used at home with the parents: First Reconciliation and First Eucharist both by Sadlier and part of their Sacrament Program.

Grade Three: We are the CHURCH: This year is all about the Church, the parish is our home, the Church prays, the early Church, the Four Marks of the Church and so on.

Grade Four: God's Law Guides Us: A closer look at sin, the commandments, Reconciliation, God's Law, the Liturgical Year and our conscience.

Grade Five: We Meet Jesus in the Sacraments: This year the children learn about the 7 Sacraments in detail and how they apply to their lives.

Grade Six: We Are God's People: This is the Old Testament year and the children will be receiving a Bible which they will be using for the year in class.

Grade Seven: The Catholic Faith Handbook for Youth: In the 7th grade the children begin with the first two units which cover The Creed and Liturgy and Sacraments.

Grade Eight: The Catholic Faith Handbook for Youth: The children finish the book with the last two units: Christian Morality and Christian Prayer.

At each grade level the children learn prayers that go with that level. They begin with simple prayers in Kindergarten and follow each year until by grade eight they should have learned all or most of the Catholic prayers that the children learn in school.

Grade 2: Is the Sacrament of Reconciliation and Eucharist year. The children are taught at home by their parents and the Catechist re-enforces what they have learned at home in the classroom along with their regular grade two information.

Grade 8: Is Confirmation and the students learn what they need to know to finish their two year preparation for this sacrament. The Catechist goes over all those things that the students should have learned in all the previous years in the program as well as readying them for their immediate preparation for the reception of the sacrament.
